



## STRUT/ CLUB LANDING CARD for DORNOCH AIRSTRIP

### The Highland Council's General Conditions of Use

This Landing Card entitles the listed aircraft registrations to an unlimited number of landings at the Dornoch Airstrip which is operated by the Highland Council and is valid from the 1st of April 2019 to 31st March 2020

- 1 Pilots will co-operate with representatives of the Operator to ensure safe flying activities at Dornoch Airstrip.
- 2 Pilots will comply with any future Rules for Users published by the Operator.
- 3 PPR is deemed to be approved for the valid period of a Landing Card. Pilots are reminded that the usual approval from RAF Tain as applicable is a separate action that is required in respect of EGD703 danger area.
- 4 An E-landing Log system will be used to record flights landing at Dornoch Airstrip. Individual pilots are required to submit details by email to [Info.aerodromes@highland.gov.uk](mailto:Info.aerodromes@highland.gov.uk) within one week from date of landing.

## STRUT/ CLUB TWO-DAY FLY-IN AGREEMENT for DORNOCH AIRSTRIP

This AGREEMENT entitles the Light Aircraft Association Highlands & Islands Strut to the use of Dornoch Airstrip (airside only), which is operated by the Highland Council, for the CLUB Annual Fly-In

### The Highland Council's General Conditions of Use

- 1 The LAA H&I Strut must submit documents no less than 28 days prior to the first date shown above in respect of:  
Public liability cover - **CLUB COMMITTEE TO OBTAIN FROM LAA HEADQUARTERS and SUBMIT**  
Safety Information/Advice to be provided to Pilots - **CLUB COMMITTEE/ SAFETY OFFICER TO MAKE READY and SUBMIT**
- 2 Pilots will co-operate with representatives of the Operator to ensure safe flying activities at Dornoch Airstrip.
- 3 Pilots will comply with any future Rules for Users published by the Operator.
- 4 PPR is deemed to be approved for visiting aircraft.
- 5 LAA H&I Strut will submit a report of the aircraft visiting Dornoch Aerodrome during the two-day fly-in to [Info.aerodromes@highland.gov.uk](mailto:Info.aerodromes@highland.gov.uk) within one month of the final day shown above. **CLUB COMMITTEE TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT**
- 6 Visiting aircraft to the Fly-In event will not be required to pay landing fees.
